Porto was the birthplace of important Portuguese personalities famous in Brazil: Pero Vaz De Caminha, Brás Cubas but also the place of the death of Teresa Cristina, Brazil last Empress in Grand Hotel Do Porto;

You will visit palaces like Palácio das Cardosas, some cafés such as “A Brasileira” and “Guarany” built by Brazilians- Portuguese citizens emigrated in Brazil who returned meanwhile, showing-off the economic wealth they had accumulated but also developing abundant charitable and philanthropic activities that define the nineteenth-century urban landscape and the culture of the city.
